New Business

Dog Park Registration

The dog park is currently closed for seeding until about Memorial Day weekend. The registration process is going to be in June/July and run from July 1-June 30. The city will be on site to register dogs with the city. Timing being worked on but should be in June.

The district will register dogs for access to the dog park who have proper registration with a city and pay a fee to be determined. The dog will be issued a collar after registration. The registration will run from July 1 to June 30 and need to be renewed each year.

Security at the Beach

Overnight security at Bayley Beach will start in late May and run through the summer.

Bayley Beach Permit Process
